Call for papers and presentations. Send in your proposals now!

You are invited to present to the annual conference of the Australia and New Zealand Education Law Association. Thirty years after the first ANZELA conference, 2020 offers a great opportunity to learn from the past and look at the future of education and law.

There will be a chance to explore and debate the emerging issues from diverse perspectives. Do join us in Wellington and contribute a paper that stimulates discussion of this vision. We seek presenters eager to address the theme by examining developments in education and law in a local, national or international context.

We are particularly interested in topics that explore the wider horizons of education and law and in comparative papers where regional differences and innovative practice can be creatively explored. The conference also provides a forum for the provision of practical insights into the field so those attending can derive information and inspiration for use in their own roles in the education and legal environment.

Proposals for the 2020 conference can be submitted for any of the following categories:

1. A refereed conference paper (full text of paper for peer review by 15 July 2020)
2. A non-refereed paper (full text of paper by 30 August 2020)
3. A workshop or panel proposal on any topic of interest. Proposals should outline the format of the workshop and a brief summary of the content. (For this option, written papers will not be required prior to the conference.)

All paper proposals should be between 250-500 words and include:

- Title of paper or presentation
- An overview of the content
- Relevance to the conference theme
- Name, address and title of author(s) / presenter(s)
- Contact detail and brief biography (50 words)

Note: papers will be 30 minutes in duration. Workshops or panel session will be 45 minutes.

Please note: those whose paper proposals are accepted will be expected to register for the conference and pay the fee. Those who are not current members of ANZELA will receive complimentary membership for 2021 with their conference registration.

Outlines for all proposals must be received by the conference organiser by 5pm Friday 27 March. The organising committee will advise all those submitting proposals of the outcome by mid-May.

Whether or not you submit a proposal, put the dates in your diary now. WOW (the World of Wearable Arts) opens in Wellington later that week. You are advised to book accommodation early and perhaps stay on to be wowed by WOW!

Accommodation for conference delegates will be held at Rydges Wellington and The Thorndon Hotel. Bookings will open in January.
